Looking for assistance caring for your pets? HSCC can help!

Our mission is to keep pets with the people who love them. Our surrender prevention programs & services are available to people who need a little extra help to care for their furry family members. *Please contact us for more information or to request assistance.*

Pet Helpline

Questions about your pet's care or behavior? HSCC's Pet Helpline is available to answer questions about pet care, offer guidance for training or behavior modification, and provide referrals to other services that can help. Pet owners can call (802)862-0135 ext. 29 or email helpline@hscvct.org to access this free service.

Spay The Mom Program

Do you have a pregnant or nursing cat or dog? HSCC can provide free spay surgery, vaccines, and microchipping for mom and find homes for her babies. We provide care for the families until they can be safely separated, and mom is returned to her owners after her spay.

Good Neighbor Program

Do you need temporary housing for your pet? HSCC can provide temporary shelter and care for owned animals whose families are experiencing a crisis or transition and are working with a social support agency. During their stay, pets receive veterinary care and plenty of TLC, all free of charge.

Community Pet Clinic

Looking for affordable veterinary care? HSCC's Community Pet Clinic (CPC) offers low-cost veterinary services for owned cats and dogs, including vaccines, nail trims, minor diagnostics, spay & neuter, and more. Visit our website to book an appointment or call (802) 923-9028.

Rainy Day Fund

Trouble affording a medical procedure for your pet? HSCC is able to offer financial assistance to residents of Chittenden and Grand Isle County who are unable to pay for emergency surgical procedures. Contact our CPC to request a sick pet visit and learn more about how we can help.

Free Pet Food Shelf

Need help providing food for your pet? HSCC maintains a free pet food shelf in our lobby, where owners can find food and other supplies during our open lobby hours: Tuesday-Friday, 1PM-5PM and Saturday, 10AM-4PM.

TNR (Trap-Neuter-Return)

Caring for a feral cat? HSCC offers humane trap rentals and TNR services for feral cats who can return to their original location with a caretaker. Services are free for local cats and include spay/neuter, ear tip, and vaccines. Contact our CPC for more information.
